

Can I join CarShare Atlantic with a Drivers License from outside of Nova Scotia?

Yes - You can apply with a valid license from another Province, the USA or other countries.

For all drivers we must have a copy or copies of your driver's abstract(s) for you covering at least the past three years. That means an official record of your driving from a legitimate authority.

Newfoundland, Labrador, New Brunswick, and P.E.I.

CarShare Atlantic obtains driving records online with the information you provide in your application, so we can process your application quickly.

Elsewhere in Canada

For the remaining Provinces and/or Territories please obtain your abstract and send to us directly.

YOU must obtain your Driver's Abstract (an official record) and have it scanned, photographed and e-mailed or mailed to us. It must be no more than six months old. Complete and submit your application online then contact CarShare Atlantic through our [online contact form](#) to tell us that you **are** getting your records.

When you obtain your abstracts, e-mail them to us through our [online contact form](#) or attach to your application.

Can I join with a Drivers License from another Country?

Yes!

You may be eligible for membership if you can provide proof of a minimum of 2 years driving experience. Proof of experience can be either of the following:

1. Obtain written authentication of minimum two years driving experience from the originating licensing agency, or from the Embassy, Consulate or High Commissioners' offices representing the jurisdiction.

The authentication letter must be on official letterhead and be written in either English or French. It must be dated and cannot be more than 6 months old. If the Authentication Letter is in a language other than English or French, it must be accompanied by a Letter of Translation from a qualified translator.

2. Alternately, our insurer may accept your previous insurance history (proof of insurance), a document from your insurance company ensuring that you were covered for a minimum of 2 continuous years and listing any claims you may have had. The coverage must be recent and the policy can not have ended more than 2 months ago. Please note that depending on the information provided by your insurer, you may need to supply additional documentation to be approved.
